 Pray for us and for all your brother priests. Amen.

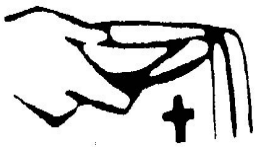
## Padre Pio Prayer Group of Dallas
