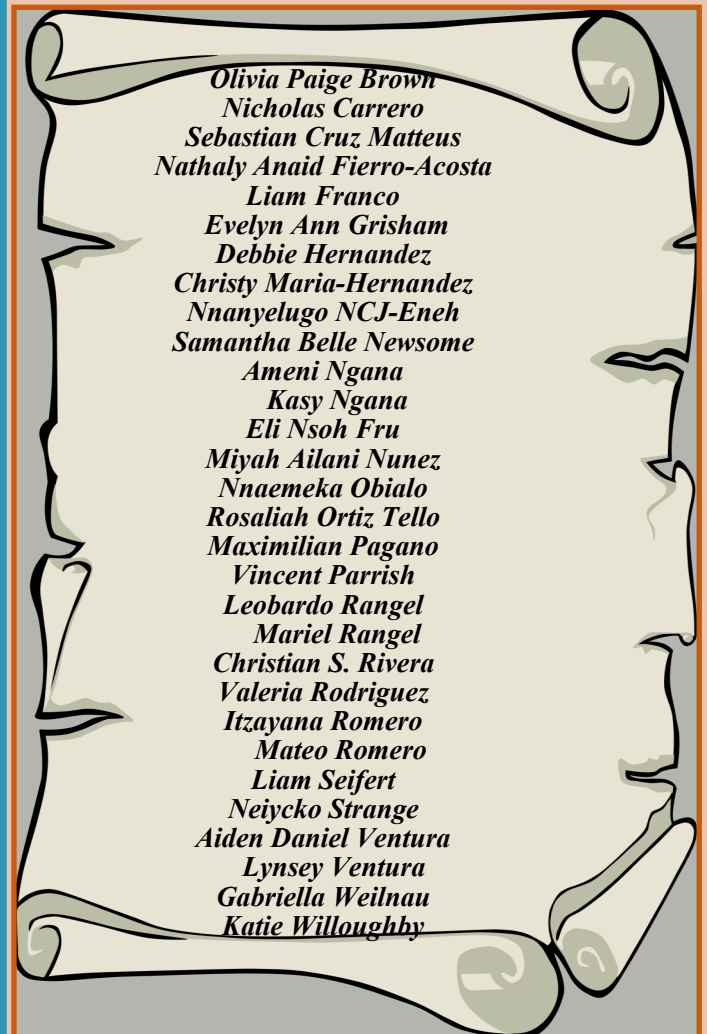

## Gospel Reading Sunday, May 17, 2026

Matthew 28: 16-20

*Jesus charges his disciples to make disciples of all nations and promises to be with them forever.*

Matthew's Gospel quickly moves from the disciples' discovery of Jesus' empty tomb, to Jesus' appearance to Mary Magdalene and the other Mary, to the commission that Jesus gives his disciples in today's Gospel.

The Final Commission, as this Gospel is sometimes called, is given on the mountaintop. Throughout Scripture, the most important events happen on the mountaintop, and Matthew has used this motif throughout his Gospel. Earlier in Matthew's Gospel, Peter, James, and John had seen Jesus transfigured on the mountaintop. Also in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus taught the crowds from the mountaintop in what we now call the Sermon on the Mount.

Here we are told that the eleven disciples go the mountaintop in Galilee, as Jesus had instructed through Mary Magdalene and the other Mary. They see Jesus, and both worship and doubt at the same time. Jesus approaches them and commissions them to baptize and teach, "to make disciples of all nations." It is a task which Jesus had previously prepared his disciples for; recall that Jesus had sent the twelve apostles to preach the Kingdom of God and to heal. However, earlier the Twelve were sent only to the House of Israel; in this Final Commission, the eleven are told to go "all nations." The mission of Jesus is now to be taken to all people; the task now is to baptize and to teach.

Jesus commissions his disciples to baptize in the name of the Trinity, one of the clearest attestations found in Scripture for baptism in the name of the Trinity. In the Acts of the Apostles and in the Letters of Paul, baptism is more frequently offered "in the name of Jesus."

The ending of Matthew's Gospel can be understood as the beginning of the Church. Jesus commissions his disciples to continue to teach in his name and to bring others into the community of disciples through baptism. The Gospel ends, as it had begun, with the promise that Jesus will continue to be Emmanuel, "God with us", for all eternity.

The first Open Registration date for 2026-2027 RE classes is May 24. Forms and information have been sent to you via email. Earlier registrations are available by appointment.

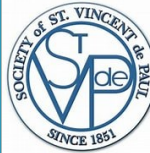
- ◆ Parents, please read the letter sent to you explaining upcoming changes to our RE Program. Let us know if you have any questions or concerns.
- ◆ We are looking for RE assistants for next year. Let us know if you are interested! Volunteer teachers and assistants receive a 50% discount on tuition for their children.
- ◆ In keeping with the Archdiocese directive of family faith formation, advancing youth ministry and changes to the process of Confirmation, we will implement several adjustments to the RE program at SVdP next year. This will include:
  1. Students in Grades 7-12 who have received First Holy Communion will meet on Wednesday evenings from 5:45—7:00 p.m.
  2. New students who have reached the age of seven or above and are in need of Baptism and/or First Holy Communion will be placed in a Sacrament Prep class on Sunday mornings. The child and a parent must both attend the class.
  3. Four Parent sessions have been included in the Religious Education Calendar next year to introduce parents to Faith Formation in the Home.
  4. For 2026-2027, Confirmation will remain limited to 10th graders or older. All Sacrament Prep classes, including First Holy Communion and Confirmation, will require a minimum of two years of formation.

*Note: For the 2026-2027 School Year, Sunday morning classes, from 10:30—11:15 will include:*

- ◆ Kindergarten
- ◆ Grades 3-4 Class
- ◆ Grades 5-6 Class
- ◆ OCIA for Children
- ◆ All First Communion classes

Classes begin on August 9, 2026. Registration is in person only. Please refer to the Open Session Registration schedule that was emailed for dates and times.

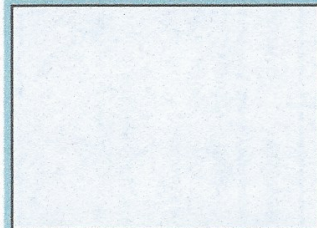
