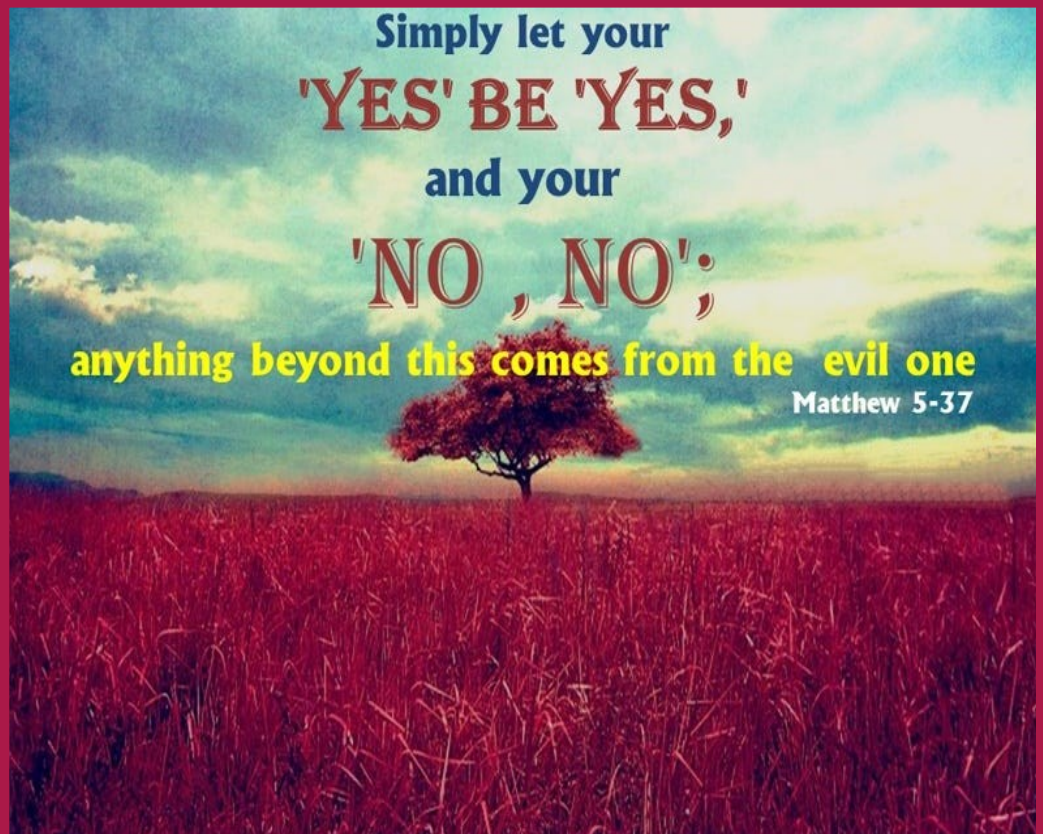

Eight Facts Most People Don't Know About How Abortion Hurts Women

1. 31% of women having abortions report suffering physical health complications.
2. 10% of women having abortions suffer immediate, potentially life-threatening complications.
3. Women have a 65% higher risk of clinical depression following abortion vs. childbirth .
4. 65% of women suffer symptoms of Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) after abortion.
5. Women's death rates from various causes after abortion are 3.5 times higher than after giving birth.
6. Many women describe their experience as 'a nightmare', which can hardly equated with 'choice'. 60% of women surveyed after abortion responded that: 'Part of me died'.
7. Suicide rates among women who have abortions are six times higher than those who give birth.
8. Abortion increases a woman's risk of future miscarriages by 60%.

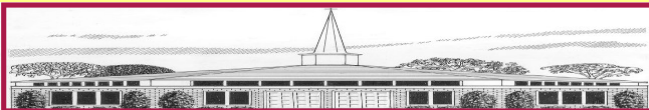

Gospel Reading-February 15, 2026

Matthew 5:17-37

I have not come to abolish the law and the prophets but to fulfill them.

Matthew continues the Sermon on the Mount with a three part instruction by Jesus on the Way of Life in the kingdom of heaven. Today's reading is part one and deals with the Law. Part two deals with worship and religious practice and contains the Lord's Prayer. Part three deals with trusting God and deeds of loving service to our neighbor.

When Matthew speaks of "the Law and the prophets" he means the whole Scripture. When the Messiah brings the fullness of the kingdom none of scripture will be done away with. Instead it will be fulfilled. Matthew's Jesus does not overturn the Law of Moses, nor does he set his followers free from the Law. He requires his followers to go beyond the Law by doing more than the Law requires.

The Law condemned murder. Jesus condemns anger. The Law condemned adultery. Jesus condemns even lustful looks. As Jewish Christians who had always been faithful to the Law Matthew's community need a way to understand the difference Jesus and the kingdom he brings have made. They affirmed that God had always been at work in history through "the Law and the prophets." But God's work goes beyond that to be embodied by the Messiah who reveals the definitive will of God. The written scriptures and their interpretation in tradition are surpassed by Jesus whose life and teaching are the definitive revelation of the will of God.

Lenten Guidelines—

The Catholic Church calls all believers to certain practices that emphasize the communal nature of repentance, especially during the Lenten season:

- Abstinence from meat - This is observed on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday**, and all the **Fridays of Lent** by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.
- Fasting - This is observed on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** by all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
- Those who are sick, pregnant, nursing, or whose health would be adversely affected by fasting and abstinence should not consider themselves bound by these norms.
